COMPLETING APPLICATIONS:

- 1) Read and complete the application thoroughly.
- 2) Follow suggested guidelines for essays, resumes, etc. and review the basis for selection.
- 3) Request grades/all official high school or college transcripts, prior to the deadline and verify with the educational institutions that transcripts have been sent.
- 4) Type your application, if at all possible. This gives the evaluator a good first impression.
- 5) Allow someone to proofread your application. They may notice something you have missed.
- 6) Include all required documents with your application.
- 7) Submit your completed application well before the deadline.

OPPORTUNITY SUGGESTIONS

- Visit your School Counselor, Multi-Cultural Coordinator/Native Student Services Coordinator or Resource Center Coordinator, etc., to inquire about various scholarship/grant/loan and internship/fellowship opportunities. They often have a bulletin board posting current opportunities.
- Meet with your selected university advisor/counselor to explore career opportunities and develop a “program plan,” listing all of the courses you will need to complete the educational requirements specifically to obtain your degree.
- Contact your Native Corporation, Tribal government, federal government, local agencies and/or supportive foundations to obtain information on available scholarships. Remember to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form.
