

JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

Behavioral Health Clinician: Full-time (37.5 hours per week) positions at the Pribilof Counseling Center at the St. Paul Health Center on St. Paul Island, and at the Oonalaska Wellness Center in Unalaska. Duties include teamwork, quality assurance, overseeing clinical records, assigning case management, and outreach to the Aleutian Pribilof regional communities; perform professional therapeutic and diagnostic counseling services in villages with clients with social, emotional, and/or substance abuse related concerns; conduct individual, family, or group counseling sessions by appointment or on an emergency basis, monitoring of patients on psychotropic medication. Hours of work 7.5 hours per day, 5 days per week with 24 hour call for psychiatric emergencies rotating with 2-3 other clinicians.

Qualifications: Master's degree in psychology, social work, counseling, human services, or other related field required. At least one year of experience in mental health, psychiatric emergency services, and/or substance abuse performed. Must be licensed or eligible to be licensed in the State of Alaska in applicants' appropriate field. Knowledge of federal confidentiality regulations and requirements. Willingness and means to travel. Good working knowledge of basic English grammar, sentence structure, and punctuation. No outstanding history of substance abuse related problems. Interest, knowledge and sensitivity to the Native lifestyle and culture. Willing to take training and attend workshops and meetings periodically to enhance job performance and knowledge.
